What do you think about the man's response to Jesus?

- What accounts for the difference between his attitude in v. 17 and his response in v. 22?

What benefits would there have been for the man if he had done what Jesus said to do? What was the cost to him of not heeding Jesus' call?

Why do you think Jesus said it is difficult for those with wealth to enter the Kingdom of God (vv. 23-25)? What obstacles do they face that a poor person does not?

How does Jesus' instruction to sell everything (v. 21) and Peter's example of leaving everything (v. 28) apply to us today as we follow Jesus?

If someone recognizes that money is an idol in their life, what should they do?

How can we pray for each other?
