## For Further Reflection and Discussion

*Opener: What would you do if you could take a day off work this week?*

How did God speak to you or work in you at church this Sunday?

Read John 4:1-32. (If you're in a group, have a few people take turns reading.) What's the setting for this story?

Who are the characters? Just based on what we read in these verses, what do we know about them?

What were some of the ways Jesus and this woman were different?

What are some of the longings people have that can only be satisfied in Jesus?

- When was the last time you talked with someone who didn't know Jesus when some of these longings come up in your conversation?

What role do miracles or other displays of God's power play in helping people come to faith? Were any involved in your own conversion story?

- What result did Jesus' word of knowledge (v. 18) produce?

How can we tell whether a question someone raises is really what is keeping them from believing, or merely a smokescreen to hide the real issue?

How do you think Jesus wanted the disciples to change based on his comments to them in vv. 34-38?

With whom do you identify in this story: the women, Jesus, or the disciples? Why?

How can we pray for each other?
